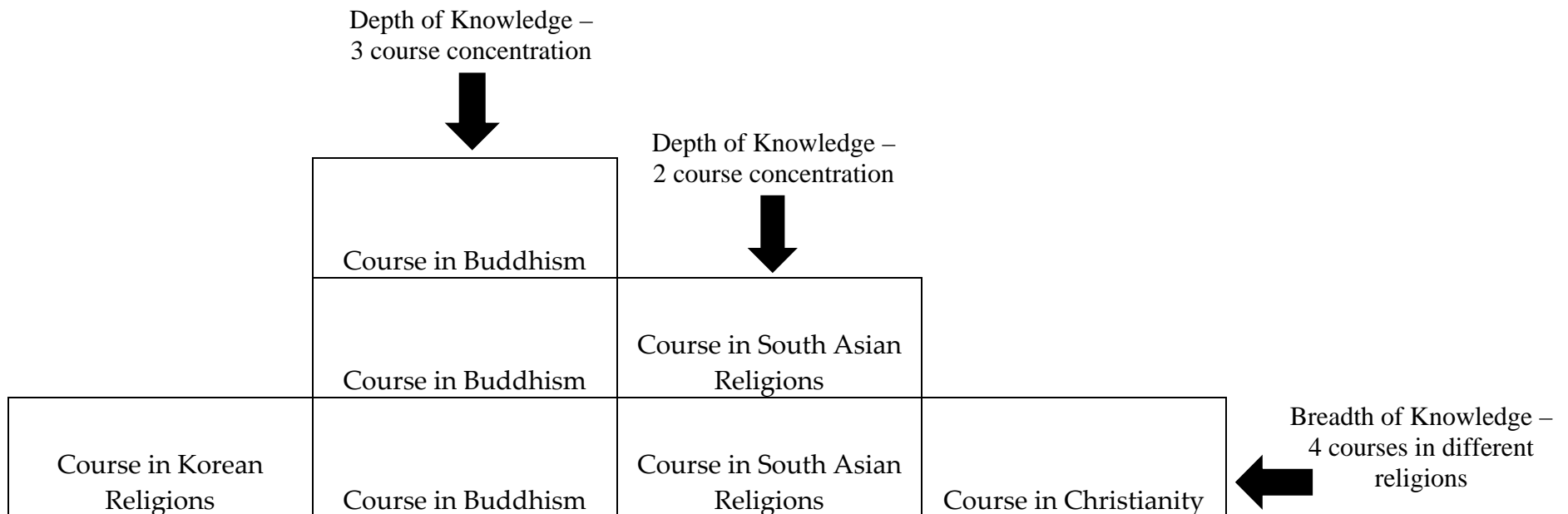


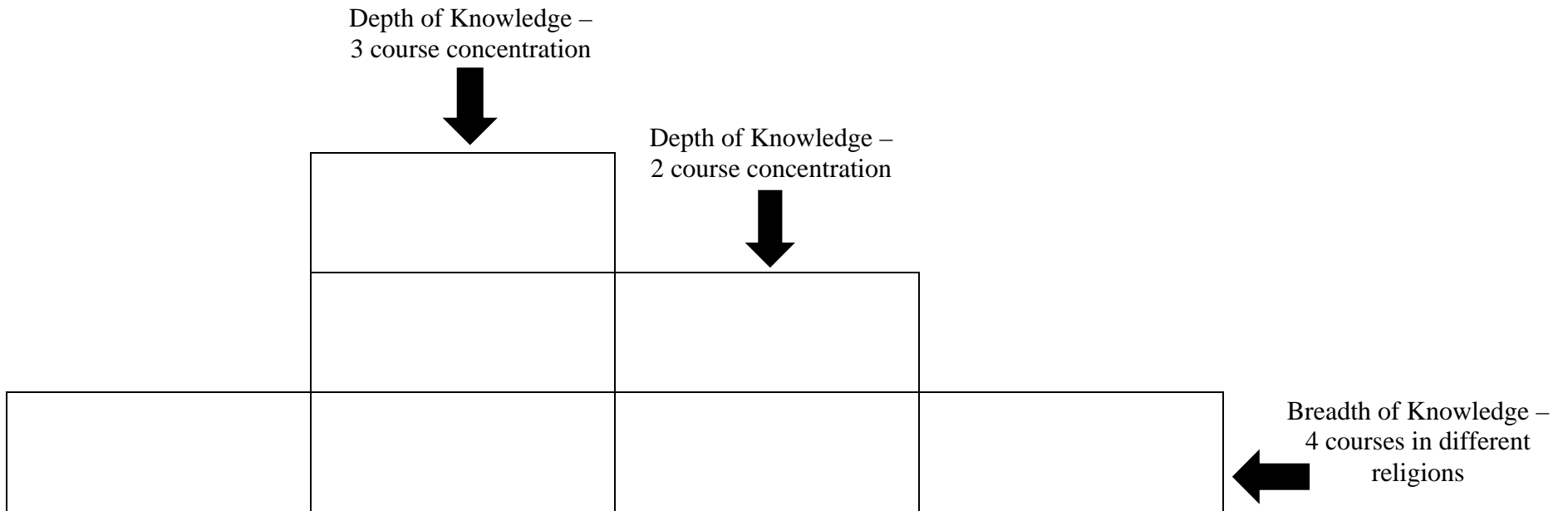
Template for elective combinations in Religious Studies

The template below is designed to help you plan your Religious Studies major electives. The sample illustrates one possible combination of the breadth and depth elective requirements. There are many possible course combinations available. Religious Studies offers a wide variety of courses, many of which are offered on a regular basis. The required core courses are taught every year: Thinking about Religion in the fall and Theories and Methods in the Study of Religion in the spring. In addition, every year we offer on a less regular schedule courses on special topics. Also note that some courses may be used to fulfill requirements in more than one area of concentration. In other words, it is unlikely that you will be able to choose all of your electives in your sophomore year. It is essential that you consult with your adviser on a regular basis.

Asian Religions Model: In the example below, the breadth requirements are fulfilled by courses in Korean Religions, Buddhism, South Asian Religions, and Christianity. The first concentration for the depth requirement is fulfilled by 3 courses in Buddhism. The second concentration for the depth requirement is fulfilled by 2 course in South Asian Religion.
